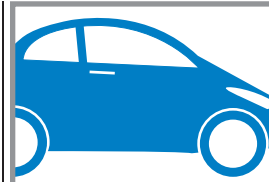

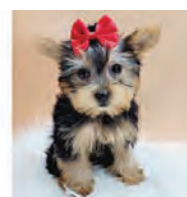

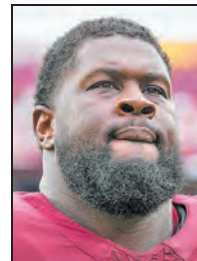

# Giants eye replacements for injured DL

The Giants last week lost a defensive lineman vying for a place in the starting lineup. On Tuesday, they worked out a few players, including one who might be able to fill that roster spot. They brought in veteran Eddie Goldman and awaited his medical reports.

Roy Robertson-Harris, who started all 17 games in 2025, his first season with the Giants, went down Thursday with a torn Achilles tendon, ending his 2026 season before it started. The interior of the defensive line already lacked proven players, and the loss intensified the search for more bulk up front.



**EDDIE GOLDMAN**

Goldman, 32, is an eight-year veteran who played 13 games (six starts) last season for the Commanders. He had 26 tackles (four for loss) before leaving the Week 15 game against the Giants with a concussion. He was a 2015 second-round draft pick of the Bears out of Florida State and had 4.5 of his 14 career sacks as a rookie.

Goldman has some blank spots on his résumé. He opted out of the 2020 COVID season, citing health concerns with his history of asthma. After he signed with the Falcons in July 2022, he announced his retirement and missed the 2022 and 2023 seasons. He came out of retirement in 2024 and played all 17 games for the Falcons.

Robertson-Harris lined up last season at defensive end. Free agent Shelby Harris and returning Chauncey Golston are on the depth chart at that spot. Darius Alexander, a 2025 third-round pick, and Zacch Pickens — claimed off waivers from the Chiefs — also are defensive linemen not considered nose tackles. Goldman, at 6-foot-3 and 320 pounds, has been more of a nose tackle in his NFL career.

# Isles give Foudy two-way deal

The Islanders signed forward Liam Foudy to a one-year, two-way contract extension, the team announced Tuesday.

Foudy, who has spent almost all of his time under contract with the Isles in the AHL, appeared in just one NHL game last season. It wasn't until the final contest of the 2025-26 campaign against the Hurricanes on April 14.

"I've watched Foudy since junior. His speed is always the first thing that pops. And everybody's looking for speed," head coach Pete DeBoer said when the team called him up. "Again, there's late bloomers all the time. There's always guys that get it a little bit later than others. That doesn't necessarily mean you're gonna hit on all those guys. And it might be one out of 10. If you can get that one out of 10 guy that is that late bloomer, that took a little bit longer, that becomes a really effective NHL player, a lot of teams have them, that's a big bonus for an organization. I think it's important to keep those guys on your radar."
